



### GATEKEEPER'S MUSEUM

The Gatekeeper's Museum is a reconstruction of the original gatekeeper's cabin - home of the watermaster who controlled the flow of water out of Lake Tahoe. Today, the museum showcases Tahoe history, from its Native inhabitants through the logging era and establishment of the tourism industry in the Tahoe Basin. The Gatekeeper's Museum also provides school tours, community events and programming for all ages.

### STEINBACH INDIAN BASKET MUSEUM

The Steinbach Indian Basket Museum displays an incredible collection of vintage and contemporary Native American basketry from throughout western North America. The collection is one of the most complete on display in the U.S. Every September, the Steinbach Museum is home to our annual Native American Basketweavers' Market, where weavers from throughout western North America demonstrate and sell their works.

### WATSON CABIN MUSEUM

Built in 1909, the Watson Cabin is the oldest building constructed on-site in Tahoe City, and is listed on the National Register of Historic Places. Today it houses exhibits about the Watson family in Lake Tahoe along with summer programming for the whole family.

### WILLIAM B. LAYTON PARK

Layton Park is a 3-acre lakefront location ideal for your wedding ceremony and/or reception. The Park offers a beautiful, secluded lakeside lawn, expanding into a rustic, forest setting. Layton Park is rich in history, beginning with the Native Washoe, who spent their summers at this location for thousands of years. Today it is home of the Gatekeeper's Museum and the Marion Steinbach Indian Basket Collection. All park rental proceeds benefit the Museums of the NLTHS. Select memberships receive a 10% discount on rental fees!
